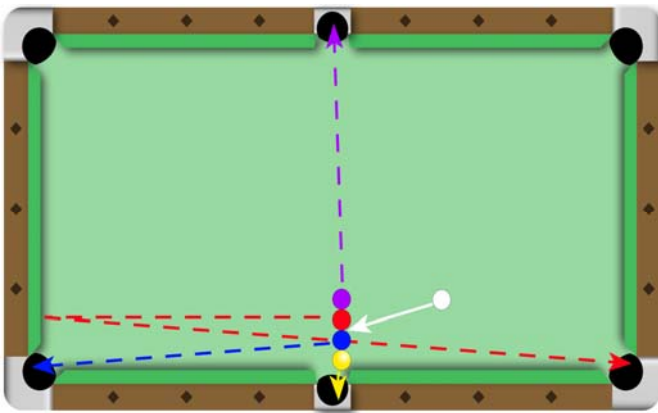

Just for Fun

Trick shots can be a lot of fun when you want to show off in front of your friends. As I travel around to host locations to meet players, many times I get requests to do trick shots. This one in particular happens to be the shot that I get asked to do the most often. It was popularized in the area because it was featured in a furniture commercial. This shot is actually over a hundred years old. It was originally published in a book titled "Trick and Fancy Pool Shots Exposed" written by Joe Hood and published in 1908. It also happens to be one of the first trick shots I ever learned on the 6 foot pool table that was in my basement as I was growing up.



Here's how it goes:

Place the one, two, three, and four ball in a straight line near the side pocket. Make sure that they are frozen to each other. Shoot the cue ball from a slight angle to the intersection of the two and three ball. The one ball will go into the side pocket. The two ball will go down to the corner. The three ball will bank to the corner pocket. The four ball will travel to the opposite side pocket. Have fun.
